



WFF Event consent agreement

28th European Fudokan Karate Championship May 7th to 10th, 2026. Sfantu Gheorghe - Covasna, Romania

PRIVACY NOTICE FOR PARTICIPANTS

As a condition for accreditation for a sports event organised by (or on behalf of) or authorised or recognised by the World Fudokan Federation ('WFF'), with registered address at Bul. Zorana Đinđića 123V/6, 11070, Beograd 27, PAK: 190311, President Office, CA Rosetti Street, No. 40, Ap. 2, Bucharest –Romania 020016, certain personal data of the participant is required.

WFF is committed to protect your privacy and shall process such personal data at this event in accordance with Romanian Law and the European legislation in this regard, in particular the Romanian Data Protection act ("GDPR") and the EU General Data Protection Regulation (Reg. 2016/679).

What personal data will be processed?

The following personal data of the participant is collected and shall be processed in the course of the organisation of the sport event:

- Full name
- Gender
- Date of birth (age)
- Diet or food restriction
- Health
- National Organization
- Karate fudokan and records Pictures/videos
- Id / Passport

In addition, the email of the parent(s) or legal guardian(s) of the participants is collected.

Should the participant fail to provide necessary requested information, WFF or the Local Organizing Committee will not be responsible for any outcomes related to this missing information.

- **For what purposes and based on what legal grounds are the personal data processed?**

The personal data is processed for the following purposes:

- to check whether the participant meets the requirements for participation as determined by the WFF;
- to contact the parents or legal guardians should this be required by the circumstances.
- to provide the participant with medical care should this be required by the circumstances.
- to facilitate accommodation and transportation during the event.
- to facilitate the participant's participation in the event;
- accreditation of the participant (e.g. provide accreditation card);
- to inform about events outcomes (results, survey, links);
- safety, health and security reasons.

The processing of the participants' personal data by the WFF is necessary to organize the event and guarantee the participants' participation (i.e. necessary to comply with its contractual and legal obligations). The processing may also be based on the legitimate interests of the WFF, for example, where it is required for safety, health and security reasons or if necessary, in the event of a dispute, to initiate or defend against legal claims. For the purposes of



enforcing the WFF Anti- Doping Rules, the processing of the personal data is based on consent, reference is made to the consent form w.r.t. the WFF Anti-Doping Rules.

WFF is committed to processing the personal data only to carry out the purposes as described above, in any event, only in the context of the organization of the event. WFF will not use the personal data for any other purpose.

- **Who has access to this personal data or who will they be transferred to?**

General organization

The personal data is uploaded on the Sport Data Software and the Electronic Registration and Accreditation System of WFF, known as the WFF ERAS platform. The personal data on the WFF ERAS platform are managed by WFF IT service providers and are accessible by the organizer (Local Organizing Committee) of the WFF event to which the participant participates. The IT providers will use the personal data to create result lists, game schedules, participant profiles, answer requests, etc. The organizer shall process the personal data organization of the event and enable the participant's participation in such event.

A contract is concluded with all these recipients, providing the necessary guarantees under data protection law. In the event such provider or organizer is established in a country without adequate level of protection as listed in the Ordinance to the GDPR, additional contractual safeguards are taken by stipulating data protection clauses in a specific contract that will be notified to the Romanian Data Protection and Information Commissioner or by concluding standard data protection clauses approved by the GDPR and/or EC Standard Clauses. Should this be required by law, the WFF can also transfer your personal data to official authorities when requested.

Pictures/videos

Without expectation of compensation or other remuneration, now or in the future, I hereby give my consent to the World Fudokan Federation and its affiliates, to use my image and/or any interview statements from me in its publications, advertising or other media activities (including the Internet). This consent includes, but is not limited to:

1. Permission to interview, film, photograph, tape, or otherwise make a video reproduction of me and/or record my voice;
2. Permission to use my name; and
3. Permission to use quotes from the interview(s), the film, photograph(s), tape(s) or reproduction(s) of me, and/or recording of my voice, in part or in whole, in its publications, in newspapers, magazines and other print media, on television, radio and electronic media (including the Internet), in theatrical media and/or in mailings for educational and awareness.

- **How long will the personal data be retained?**

The personal data is deleted six months after the end of the event, unless the law would require otherwise or, as the case may be, the personal data is needed to handle a dispute or question of an official authority after the end of these six months.

In the event you consented to the processing of your pictures/videos, these personal data will be retained as long as they are relevant and useful in the context of advertising and marketing campaigns. When outdated they will be no longer used and deleted, unless it is decided that they are further processed for archiving purposes.



- **What are my rights with regards to the processing of the personal data?**

You are entitled to access your personal data and have them corrected when inaccurate or incomplete, to have them erased and to object to the processing thereof or have the processing thereof restricted, when the legal conditions there to are met. Please note that the WFF, the organizer, and as the case may be, other partners helping out with the organization of the event, may not be able to comply with our/their legal or contractual obligations (and cannot be held liable in this regard), such as refusing participation in the event.

To the extent that the processing is based upon consent, you can withdraw your consent at any time.

You are entitled to obtain a copy of your personal data (in a structured, commonly used, machine-readable format) and to have your personal data transferred to another controller (right to data portability).

- **Who can I speak to when I have questions or want to exercise my rights?**

If you have a question or complaint regarding the processing of your personal data or you would like to exercise your rights outlined above, the following persons can be contacted:

The Participant has the right to make a formal complaint to the relevant authorities on data protection should they deem their rights have not been respected.



CONSENT FORM • WFF ANTI-DOPING RULES

As a member of WFF and/or a participant in an event authorized or recognized by WFF, I hereby declare as follows:

1. I acknowledge that I am bound by, and confirm that I shall comply with, all of the provisions of the WFF Anti-Doping Rules (as amended from time to time), the World Anti-Doping Code (the “Code”) and the International Standards issued by the World Anti-Doping Agency, as amended from time to time, and published on WADA’s website.
2. I acknowledge the authority of WFF [and its member National Federations and/or National Anti-Doping Organizations] under the WFF Anti-Doping Rules to enforce, to manage results under, and to impose sanctions in accordance with the WFF Anti-Doping Rules.
3. I acknowledge and agree that any dispute arising out of a decision made pursuant to the WFF Anti-Doping Rules, after exhaustion of the process expressly provided for in the WFF Anti-Doping Rules, may be appealed exclusively as provided in Article 12 of the WFF Anti-Doping Rules to an appellate body for final and binding arbitration, which in the case of International-Level Athletes is the Court of Arbitration for Sport (CAS).
4. I acknowledge and agree that the decisions of the appellate body referenced above shall be final and enforceable, and that I will not bring any claim, arbitration, lawsuit or litigation in any other court or tribunal.
5. I understand that:
 - a. my data, such as my name, contact information, birthdate, gender, sport nationality, voluntary medical information, and information derived from my testing sample will be collected and used by WFF Anti-Doping Rules [and its member National Federations and/or National Anti-Doping Organizations] and WADA for anti-doping purposes;
 - b. WADA-accredited laboratories will use the anti-doping administration and management system (“ADAMS”) to process my laboratory test results for the sole purpose of anti-doping, but shall only have access to de-identified, key-coded data that will not disclose my identity;
 - c. I may have certain rights in relation to my Doping Control-related data under applicable laws and under WADA’s International Standard for the Protection of Privacy and Personal Information (ISPPPI), including rights to access, rectification, restriction, opposition and deletion, and remedies with respect to any unlawful processing of my data, and I may also have a right to lodge a complaint with a national regulator responsible for data protection in my country;



d. if I object to the processing of my Doping Control-related data or withdraw my consent, it still may be necessary for WFF [and its member and National Anti-Doping Organizations] and/or WADA to continue to process (including retain) certain parts of my Doping Control-related data to fulfil obligations and responsibilities arising under the Code, International Standards or national anti-doping laws notwithstanding my request; including for the purpose of investigations or proceedings related to a possible anti-doping rule violations; or to establish, exercise or defend against legal claims involving me, WADA and/or an Anti-Doping Organization.

e. preventing the processing, including disclosure, of my Doping Control-related data may prevent me, WADA or Anti-Doping Organizations from complying with the Code and relevant WADA International Standards, which could have consequences for me, such as an anti-doping rule violation, under the Code;

f. to the extent that I have any concerns about the processing of my Doping Control-related data I may consult with the WFF and/or WADA (privacy@wada-ama.org), as appropriate.

6. I understand and agree to the possible creation of my profile in ADAMS, which is hosted by WADA on servers based in Canada, and/or any other authorized National Anti-Doping Organization's similar system for the sharing of information, and to the entry of my Doping Control, whereabouts, Therapeutic Use Exemptions, Athlete Biological Passport, and sanction-related data in such systems for the purposes of anti-doping and as described above. I understand that if I am found to have committed an anti-doping rule violation and receive a sanction as a result, that the respective sanctions, my name, sport, Prohibited Substance or Method, and/or tribunal decision, may be publicly disclosed by WFF and its member National Federations and/or National Anti-Doping Organizations] in accordance with the Code. I understand that my information will be retained for the duration as indicated in the ISPPPI.

7. understand and agree that my information may be shared with competent Anti-Doping Organizations and public authorities as required for anti-doping purposes. I understand and agree that persons or parties receiving my information may be located outside the country where I reside, including in Switzerland and Canada, and that in some other countries data protection and privacy laws may not be equivalent to those in my own country. I

understand that these entities may rely on and be subject to national anti-doping laws that override my consent or other applicable laws that may require information to be disclosed to local courts, law enforcement, or other public authorities. I can obtain more information on national anti-doping laws from my International Federation or National Anti-Doping Agency.
